# Harvest Festival – Friday 18th October

On Friday 18th October at 9.00am we will be holding Harvest Festival Assemblies in each of the school halls, for the children. Year 4 will be leading the assembly for KS2. We are asking

children to donate food, from **Monday 14th October**, so that we can collect it to give to Luton Foodbank. The food needs to be non-perishable so I have listed below the types of food that would be ideal. Please send into school by the morning of **Friday 18th October**.

Every day people in the UK go hungry for reasons ranging from redundancy to receiving an unexpected bill on a low income. Luton Foodbank provide emergency food supplies for people in crisis. Thank you, in anticipation, for your support and generosity.

#### Suitable items:

Fruit Juice (Carton) Milk (UHT/Powdered) Meat/fish (Tinned) Rice Pudding/Custard (Tinned) Tea Bags/Instant Coffee Sugar/Jam Breakfast Cereal Tinned Tomatoes Vegetables (Tinned) Dried Rice (500g) Pasta Sauce Soup Baked Beans (Tinned) Biscuits

Other items such as shampoo, toilet rolls and washing up liquid are also very welcome.

### **Education Sunday**

Thank you to all of the families who attended mass at St Martin de Porres Church over the weekend. It was an amazing turnout for the both masses. Father Simon has also asked me to pass on his thanks.

#### Nuts and fish

We have had several instances over the last two weeks of children having either fish or products containing nuts in their packed lunches. We have several children with severe allergies to fish and/or nuts. If they come into contact with fish or nuts (e.g. touching a door handle when someone else has eaten nuts/fish and has touched the door handle or being in the same room as someone eating nuts), they could go into anaphylactic shock, which in the worst cases, can lead to death.

### So please do not send your child with products such as:

- Peanut butter, Snickers, Nutella or other chocolate spreads, 'Celebration' sweets or variety packs containing any type of nuts,
- No fish fingers, tuna, sardines, mackerel, fish paste, prawns or any other type of fish.

### Healthy packed lunches

I am aware that a small number of children are coming into school with packed lunches that are decidedly unhealthy. Please find below an example of what a packed lunch might look like:

Sandwich/roll/wrap (savoury not sweet)

Piece of fruit/yoghurt/raw vegetables

Small biscuit bar (not sweets/chocolate) Drink (not fizzy)

### Uniform

Please can I remind you of a number of issues around uniform that I have noticed with just a few children:

- Earrings are not allowed. However, a stud (not hooked or looped) in each ear is.
- Tracksuits for outdoor PE should not be worn until after half term and should be plain navy blue or black in colour with no logos.
- Hair can be as short as you like but please avoid lines and shaved sides with longer hair on top.
- School bags need to be a reasonable size **a small back pack** we do not have room for larger bags in the cloakrooms.
- Children need to wear shoes, **not boots.**

### **Play equipment**

Please do not allow your children to play on the climbing equipment outside the Early Years or on the grassed area next to KS2 playground. The equipment is only to be used during school hours and must be supervised by a member of staff.
